

PDRL PLAYER CLEARANCE JOURNEY

APPLYING FOR CLASSIFICATION FOR INTERNATIONAL RUGBY LEAGUE









Nation distributes documentation a) Sensitive Data & Operational Rule Consent form (SDORC)

b) Medical Diagnostics Form (MDF)



The completed SDORC and MDF are returned to a NF PDRL contact to submit to the NF Eligibility Officer (EO)



Federation (NF)





IRL Authorising Officers (AO) will process national eligibility documents + SDORC



IRL Head of Classification (HOC) is informed and given unique access to the player's eligibility folder by an AO through classification@intrl.sport




IRL HOC decides whether to:

a) invite the player for classification

b) request further medical information from the player via standardised letter (this exchange of further information is between HOC and player, copying NF PDRL contact)

c) inform the player, via standardised letter that is copied to the NF PDRL contact, that their condition is not recognised as an eligible impairment as set out in the IRL Eligibility Criteria. HOC to record Not Eligible status on player database







HOC & NF coordinate a time and venue for classification opportunity. Invitation is sent to the player by NF

FOLLOWING CLASSIFICATION



IRL classifier provides classification card to NF. The EO uploads classification card to the player's folder

a) player is eligible for PDRL profile, class and tackling status added to the database, along with review date if applicable

b) player is not eligible for PDRL status recorded on database



Player is informed of decision by IRL, copying in NF
